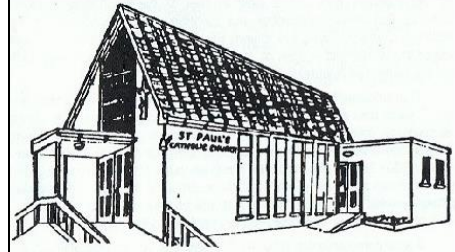

### Feasts this week

Monday	St Andrew Kim Taegon - the first Korean priest, St Paul Chong Hasang and their Companions, were martyred in Korea in the 19 <sup>th</sup> century.
Tuesday	St Matthew, one of the Apostles, author of the first Gospel he was martyred in Persia.
Thursday	St. Pius, better known as Padre Pio, A priest who had the wounds of Christ's passion on his body, he became famous as a confessor, for spiritual direction and miracles. Despite his popularity, he faced opposition, even from church authorities.
Friday	Our Lady of Walsingham, in a vision Our Lady asked the Lady of the Manor, Richeldis, to build a replica of the house where the Annunciation took place. She had a simple wooden house built and later a stone church to protect it. Walsingham is still a place of pilgrimage.

Saturday Andrew Brookes who grew up in our Parish is to be ordained to the Order of Preachers (The Dominicans). He is the fifth man to be ordained as a Priest from this Parish. Please keep him in your prayers.
