<u>QE Hospital</u> – Currently there is not a full time Priest. Please make sure that your hospital registration details include that you are a Catholic. Do not wait until a point of crisis before you ask for a Priest and ask Father Barry for the Sacrament of the Sick if you know you are going into Hospital for major surgery.

**<u>B30 Foodbank</u>** - Last week we received in 1,178kgs, we gave out 1,952kgs,1,754kgs to 153 people and 198kgs to other foodbanks. Urgently needed, instant coffee (not decaf), sugar 500g, potato smash gender neutral shampoo, disposable razors, strong carrier bags, toilet rolls, washing up liquid (not family sized)
