**B30 Foodbank** - Last week we received in donations 1,378kgs and we gave out 1,975kgs, 1,853kgs to feed 158 people, 110kgs to Food Cycle and sadly we had 83kgs of food that was out of date. Urgently needed; Sugar 500g (not larger), potato smash, jam/honey, porridge, cereal (upto 500g), UHT whole milk or semi-skimmed milk, long-life fruit juice, tinned tomatoes and tinned rice pudding.
