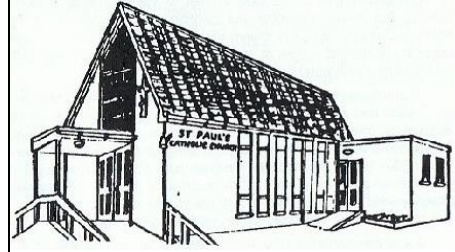

Monday	St. Francis of Assisi, renounced his privileged family life and became a monk to live a simple life. With St. Clare he laid the foundations for the Franciscan Order.
Tuesday	Saint Faustina, was a Polish nun and mystic who lived from 1905 to 1938. Her apparitions of Jesus Christ inspired the devotion to the Divine Mercy
