Tuesday	St. Andrew a fisherman from Bethsaida one of the first Apostles with St Peter; he preached the Gospel in Greece and was crucified. He is the patron saint of Scotland.
Wednesday	St Edmund Campion, was born a Protestant, converted, went to a seminary in France. He returned, disguised as a jewel merchant but was caught and executed for being a Priest.
Friday	St Frances Xavier, Priest, one of the founders of the Jesuit order, he was the first Jesuit to go to Japan as a missionary and is the patron saint of missionaries.
Saturday	St John Damascene, was a monk, teacher and philosopher from Damascus. He defended sacred art against the Iconoclasts in the 8th Century.
