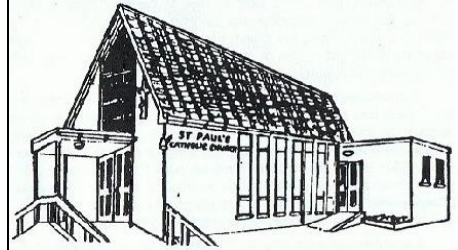

Saints of the Week

Monday	St Mary Magdalene, was one of the few who remained with Christ during his agony on the cross and it was to her that Our Lord first appeared after his resurrection.
Tuesday	St Bridget of Sweden, was a Queen of Sweden who after her husband's death dedicated herself to an ascetic and contemplative life as a Franciscan tertiary, She died in Rome.
Wednesday	St Charbel Makhluf, was a Lebanese Maronite Catholic priest, monk, and hermit During his life he obtained a reputation for holiness and he is known for miraculous cures of the sick.
Thursday	St James the Apostle, called the 'Great' as he was called by Christ before the other St James. With Peter and John, he was at the Transfiguration and the agony in the Garden.
Friday	Saints Joachim Anne, the parents of The Blessed Virgin Mary. It was in their home she received her training to be the Mother of God. Devotion to Anne and Joachim is an extension of affection Christians have always professed towards our Blessed Mother.
Saturday	Blessed Robert Sutton, Priest and Martyr of the Reformation. He and his two brothers became Priests. He was arrested at Stafford for being a Priest and executed in 1588.
