

Monday	St Pio of Pietrelcina, better known as Padre Pio. Bearing the wounds of Christ's passion on his body, he became famous as a confessor, for spiritual direction and his miracles.
Tuesday	Our Lady of Walsingham - the Lady of the Manor, Richeldis de Faverches, had a vision of the house where the Annunciation took place and Our Lady asked to build a replica.
Thursday	St Cosmas and St Damian, were twins who were doctors, in a seaport. They gave their services for free and this gained them the nickname the "Holy Unmercenaries".
Friday	St Vincent de Paul, was a priest who dedicated himself to the evangelisation and care of the poor, unfortunate and the suffering. We see his work today in the SVP.
Saturday	St Wenceslaus was King of Bohemia he was killed at what should have been a truce. St Lawrence Ruiz is the first Filipino to be canonised. He was martyred at Nagasaki in 1637.
