

Monday	Blessed Nicolas Barre. The patron saint of the Sanctuary Project. A priest known for his holiness and spiritual direction who was sought by the well off but preferred the poor.
Tuesday	St John Paul II, Pope The first Polish Pope, he had to study in secret for the priesthood.
Wednesday	St John of Capistrano, priest A great Franciscan preacher in the 15th century who at the age of 70 was a leader of an army that liberated Belgrade from the Turks.
Thursday	St Anthony Mary Claret, Bishop. A Jesuit and later Archbishop of Cuba he became Confessor to the Queen of Spain and worked to organise the First Vatican Council
Saturday	St Cedd, who with his brother Chad was educated at Lindisfarne. They both became Bishops, Chad at Lichfield for Mercia and Cedd for East Saxons at Bradwell
