Monday	The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary This feast began in the Eastern
	church in the 7th century spreading across the western church over the next 3 centuries.
Tuesday	St Edmund Gennings, Priest & Martyr A protestant convert from Lichfield he was martyred
-	for being a Priest in 1591 after serving in England for just one year.
Wednesday	St Damasus I, Pope. Born in Spain in 305 he called synods and councils to work against
-	schismatics and heretics and widely promoted devotion to the Martyrs
Thursday	Our Lady of Guadalupe. In 1531 Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego an Aztec labourer.
Friday	St Lucy, virgin and martyr. probably during the persecution of Diocletian. From antiquity, her
-	cult spread throughout the Church. Her name is in the Roman Canon
Saturday	St John of the Cross, born in Spain. After a number of years as a Carmelite, he was
_	persuaded by St. Teresa of Jesus to lead and reform the Carmelite Order.
